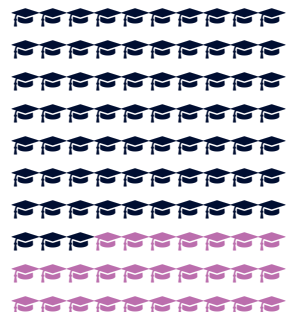

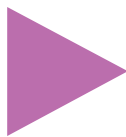
- Access to a **labour pool of over 5.1 million people** within the Toronto Region, representing over 60% of Ontario's Labour force

EDUCATING & INNOVATING THE NEXT GENERATION

Mississauga is home to leading post-secondary institutions with a wide range of life sciences related programs.

University of Toronto-Mississauga (UTM) Academy of Medicine and the Institute for Management & Innovation offer professional graduate programs in biotechnology, innovation and sustainability management.

UTM has established a new Centre for Medicinal Chemistry that focuses on the development of new drugs targeting cancer and other diseases.

UTM is also home to SpinUp, a wet lab incubator that supports early-stage life science companies and entrepreneurs offering access to subsidized space including specialized equipment, fumehoods and programming.

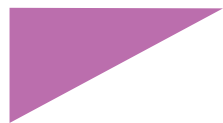

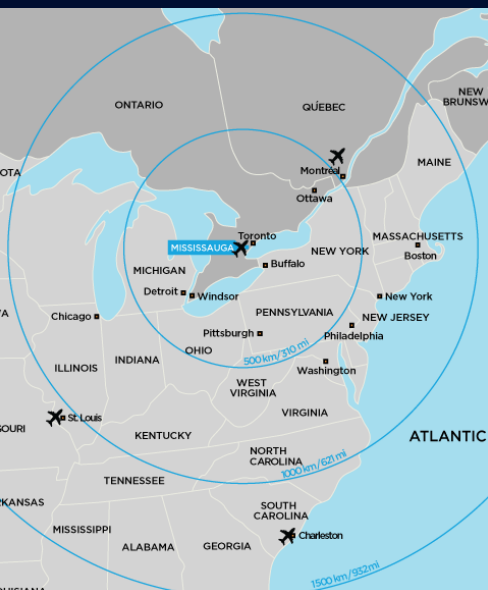
